**2019 Northern Shenandoah Valley Quilt Show**  
**Rules and Regulations**  
**"All Creatures Great & Small"      April 12, 13, 14, 2019**

These Entry Rules are to be kept and adhered to by the Entrant

1. The Theme of the 2019 Northern Shenandoah Valley Quilt Show (NSVQS) is "All Creatures Great & Small". Any interpretation of the theme may be entered in this special category. However, any type of quilt may be entered into the show regardless of theme.
2. A four-inch (4") sleeve must be attached to the back of each quilt so that it may be hung properly for display. For instructions on how to make a sleeve, visit the show website at [www.nsvquiltshow.com](http://www.nsvquiltshow.com).
3. **Each quilt/item must have the entrant's name, phone number, and name of the quilt/item on the back, lower-left corner.** If your permanent label is elsewhere on your quilt, please attach a temporary label with the requested information on the back, lower-left corner. In the case of wearable art, please include a blouse or shirt (also labeled with your name) to hang under your entry for display.
4. The completed registration/s with photo/s must be received no later than **February 22, 2019** for entry into the show. **\*\*NEW!\*\*** Registration may be completed *online*, or a copy of the registration may be printed from our website to mail. **A maximum of 5 items per person may be entered and each item entered must have its own registration form.** Completed *printed* registration forms and photos should be mailed to: NSVQS, % Skyline Quilters, PO Box 514, Stephens City, VA 22655 and *must* be postmarked by February 18, 2019. Registrations submitted online after February 22 or postmarked after February 18 will not be accepted due to print deadlines. Photos must be emailed to [nsvquilts@gmail.com](mailto:nsvquilts@gmail.com).
5. All Registered items must include a photo of a completed quilt top or item. Photos of fabric choices and the pattern to be used are not acceptable. Photos must be taken of the quilt hanging flat, showing the entire quilt from side to side and top to bottom. If registering online, a .jpeg no larger than 10 MB must be uploaded at the end of the registration form. If mailing in your registration, then a printed copy must accompany the registration form. 6. Please bring your quilts to the Clarke County Parks and Recreation Center (255 Al Smith Circle, Berryville, VA which is on business route 7) **between 9:30-11:30 am on Thursday, April 11, 2019.** **\*\*\*\*To make the process faster once you arrive, please have your quilt folded with the BACK out, lower left corner on top, so that your label is showing.**

7. Upon arrival at the CCPR Center, your item/s will be signed in, tagged, and a receipt for each item will be given to the person bringing in the item/s. You must keep these receipts, as you will need them in order to have your item/s returned to you when you pick them up on Sunday, April 14.
8. **You must pick up your item/s at the CCPR Center between 4:45 pm and 5:30 pm on Sunday, April 14, 2019.** Every effort will be made to have all quilts available for pick-up by 4:45. Please trust that our volunteers will be preparing them as quickly as possible for pickup, but it is possible that you may have a short wait. We greatly appreciate patience from all participants!
9. When picking up your item/s, please have your receipt/s ready that you were given at registration on Thursday, April 11. They are proof of ownership and are **required** when picking up your item/s. *No items will be released without the receipt/s!* You must sign for each item that you pick up. If you are personally not able to pick up your item/s, please inform us at the time of drop off and make sure your representative has your receipt/s or your item/s will not be released.
10. Quilts previously entered into the NSVQS will not be accepted, with exception to the 2017 Best In Show winner.
11. **NEW! SELLING YOUR QUILTS!** *Only quilts entered in the NSVQS can be sold at the show, unless you are a vendor. The NSVQS is not responsible to facilitate any part of the sale and will not be involved in any part of a monetary transaction. You must indicate during registration if your quilt is for sale or not. Please see the FAQs for more information.*
